## Writing your bio:

Once you have your twenty sentences you can begin the process of editing and connecting, using the sentences to give the reader a sense of who you are.

## Example:

*June was the recipient of the New Arts Grant in 2017. June was born and raised in Windsor, ON. June earned a BA with a concentration in Studio Arts from the University of Windsor in 2019.*
